

**Synopsis of Bylaw No. 4484**

The intent of Bylaw No. 4484, the “Southern Gulf Islands Transportation Service Establishing Bylaw No. 1, 2022” is to establish a new integrated transportation service for the Southern Gulf Islands Electoral Area to coordinate, fund, and operate land and water-based transportation services within the electoral area. The bylaw permits the CRD to raise a maximum annual requisition for the purpose of funding the service to the greater of six hundred and seventy five thousand dollars (\$675,000) or \$0.1414 per one thousand dollars (\$1,000) of taxable land and improvements in the service area. The maximum requisition is the upwards limit of what would be collected.
