4.2. <u>25-1030</u>

Saanich Peninsula Wastewater Service 2026 Capital and Operating Budget

A. Fraser presented Item 4.2.

Discussion ensued regarding:

- cost difference between tipping sludge and processing biosolids
- approximate timeline for finalization of biosolids contract

MOVED by Commissioner Novek, SECONDED by Commissioner McNeil-Smith, The Saanich Peninsula Wastewater Commission recommends that the Committee of the Whole recommend that the Capital Regional District Board:

- 1. Approve the 2026 Saanich Peninsula trunk sewers, treatment and disposal operating and capital budget and the 2026 Saanich Peninsula Liquid Waste Management Plan (LWMP) program budgets including the LWMP administration budget, the Saanich Peninsula Stormwater Quality Management Program budget and the Saanich Peninsula Stormwater Source Control budget;
- 2. Direct staff to update carry forward balances in the 2026 Capital Budget for changes after year end; and
- 3. Direct staff to balance the 2025 actual revenue and expense on the transfer to capital reserve fund.

5. Notice of Motion

5.1. 25-1212

Notice of Motion: Staff Investigation into Expansion of Waste Heat District Energy System (Commissioners Kelbert/King/Diller)

Chair Kelbert provided the following Notice of Motion for consideration at the next Saanich Peninsula Wastewater Commission meeting:

WHEREAS the Saanich Peninsula Wastewater Treatment Plant currently supplies recovered heat to the Panorama Recreation Centre through an established District Energy System (DES);

AND WHEREAS there is a potential opportunity to expand the current DES beyond institutional use to include residential properties located along the corridor between the treatment plant and the recreation centre;

AND WHEREAS expanding the DES to nearby residential properties may offer significant energy savings by replacing less efficient electric baseboard heating with a centralized, renewable thermal energy source;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Commission direct staff to investigate and report back on the steps required to develop a pilot project to convert residential household heating to waste heat, utilizing the existing DES infrastructure;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the staff report should include feasibility considerations such as a subsidized fixed per-month household cost model for participating homes, under an estimated 20-year term.
