

REPORT TO HIGHLAND WATER AND SEWER AND HIGHLAND FERNWOOD WATER SERVICES MEETING OF THURSDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2020

SUBJECT

Bylaw 4371 – Salt Spring Island Water, Sewer, and Liquid Waste Disposal Commission Bylaw No. 1, 2010, Amendment No. 1 2020

ISSUE SUMMARY

To amend Bylaw No. 3693 to continue and update the Salt Spring Island water, sewer and liquid waste disposal commission as it relates to the Highland Water and Sewer service and Fernwood Water and Highland Water service.

BACKGROUND

In December 8, 2010 the Board approved establishment of the Highland Fernwood Water Service (Bylaw 3753) for servicing and debt associated with construction of new water treatment plant.

With the merging of these two water local area services a commission establishment bylaw should have been established at the same time. Bylaw 4371 establishes the Highland and Fernwood Water Commission and the Maliview Sewer Commission; and discontinues the Fernwood Water Local Service Commission and the Highland Water and Sewer Services Commission.

ALTERNATIVES

Alternative 1

The Fernwood Water Local Service Commission and the Highland Water and Sewer Services Commission recommends that the Electoral Areas Committee recommends to the Capital Regional District Board:

- 1. That Bylaw 4371, "Salt Spring Island Water, Sewer, and Liquid Waste Disposal Commission Bylaw No. 1, 2010, Amendment No. 1, 2020" be introduced and read a first, second, and third time;
- 2. That Bylaw 4371 be adopted.

Alternative 2

That the matter be referred back to staff for additional information.

IMPLICATIONS

There are no financial or service delivery implications associated with the bylaw amendment. The change is a housekeeping matter to ensure the commissions are established in accordance with the service establishment.

CONCLUSION

The amendment is required to establish a commission for the services provide for within both the Highland and Fernwood Water and the Maliview Sewer service areas.

RECOMMENDATION

The Fernwood Water Local Service Commission and the Highland Water and Sewer Services Commission recommends that the Electoral Areas Committee recommends to the Capital Regional District Board:

- 1. That Bylaw 4371, "Salt Spring Island Water, Sewer, and Liquid Waste Disposal Commission Bylaw No. 1, 2010, Amendment No. 1, 2020" be introduced and read a first, second, and third time.
- 2. That Bylaw 4371 be adopted.
