- 69% said not having a family doctor was their most important issue (2023 Household Prosperity Survey)
- Community well-being one of six strategic priorities
- Business plan goal: Connect 10,000
 Colwoodians to family doctors

New Municipal Model: Blazing the Trail



- City: administration, recruitment, information technology, communication, finance, payroll
- Doctors: provide exceptional healthcare not worry about business
- Doctors are employees: salary, defined pension, paid benefits, paid vacation, paid maternity & paternity leave
- Recruitment and retention
- Quality of life for doctors (work life balance)
- Partnership with developers and businesses



Municipalities: An Untapped, Yet Ideal Vehicle for Delivering Primary Care



- Cities deliver most services that affect social determinants of health – zoning, transport, parks/rec, housing, etc.
- Cities know their unique needs
- Cities can marry primary care to overall community strategies to address these critical issues

This can create a deliberate social environment for community health



Municipal Clinic



- Lease agreement
- Employment contracts
- Information Technology
- Medical equipment
- Electronic Medical Record system
- Medical Clinic Foundation: Equipment and recruitment



- High expression of interest
- Clinic opened January 27, 2025
- One doctor hired & practicing
- Two additional out-of-province doctors have accepted employment offers
- Rapid patient growth (530+)
- Sustainable workload is achievable

Challenges



- BC Attachment Too Slow
- Shadow-billing: time/money sink
- Delay between on-boarding and full physician utilization results in increased cash burn
- Licensing and Onboarding Maze for International Recruits

Collaborative Solutions



Colwood Attachment List

- City advertising campaign
- Create process for back-up "unattached resident list"

Municipal Medical Contract

- No access to new-to-practice (NTP) contracts (desirable for out-of-region hires)
- Guarantee of attachment per FTE & provides control over deployment across province
- City takes on risk of cost over-runs beyond amount paid by Province
- Could be designed to include NPs or MDs.

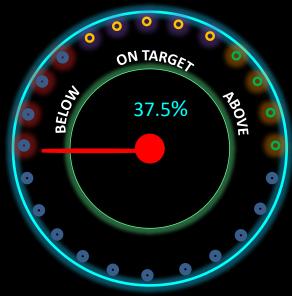


Key Lessons Learned

- **5** Dedicated Project Manager and City Team

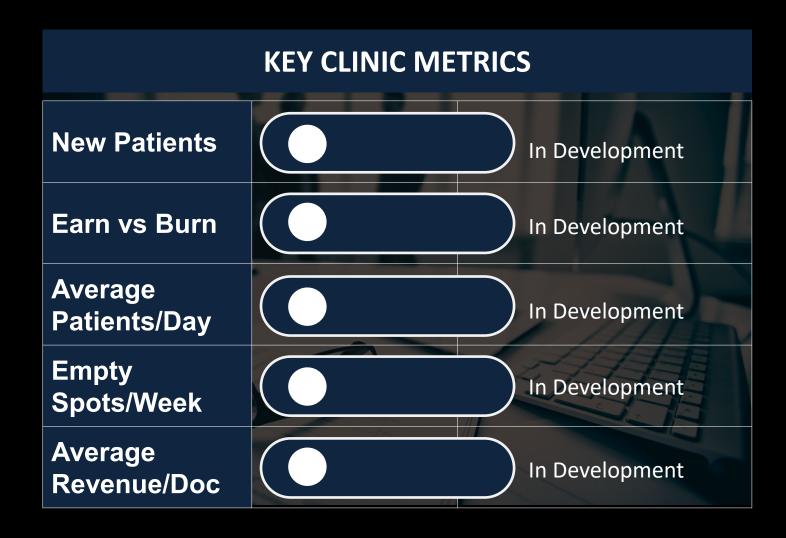
