CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT BYLAW NO. 4371

A BYLAW TO MERGE THE HIGHLAND AND FERNWOOD WATER COMMISSIONS AND ESTABLISH A COMMISSION FOR MALIVIEW SEWERAGE SYSTEM (BYLAW NO. 3693)

WHEREAS:

- A. Under Bylaw No. 3693, Salt Spring Island Water, Sewer and Liquid Waste Disposal Commissions Bylaw No. 1, 2010, the Regional Board established commissions to administer various water, sewer, and liquid waste services on Salt Spring Island, including the Fernwood Water Commission, managing Fernwood Water Supply Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1, 1989 (Bylaw No. 1772); and the Highland Water and Sewer Services Commission, administering the Highland Water System Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1, 1991 (Bylaw No. 1937) and the Maliview Estates Sewerage Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1, 1991 (Bylaw No. 1938);
- B. For some time, the Fernwood and Highland Commissions have functioned as a joint commission with shared membership, and administered the Maliview Sewer Local Service with a subset of members; and
- C. The Board wishes to amend Bylaw No. 3693 to merge the Fernwood and Highland Water Commission functions, and create a commission for Maliview Sewer Local Service administration;

NOW THEREFORE, the Capital Regional District Board in open meeting assembled hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw No. 3693, "Salt Spring Island Water, Sewer and Liquid Waste Disposal Commissions Bylaw No. 1, 2020" is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) By removing section 2(g) and rearranging remaining list items 2(h), 2(i), and 2(j) into 2(g), 2(h), and 2(i), accordingly.
 - (b) By replacing the table under section 3(a), with the following table:

- (c) In Schedule "A", in section 1, Membership, by replacing section 1(d) with the following:
 - 1(d) The Fernwood and Highland Water Service Commission, administering the Fernwood Water Local Service Area and the Highland Water Local Service Area, shall consist of the Director plus four (4) other persons appointed by resolution of the Regional Board as follows:
 - (i) Three members shall be resident electors of the Highland Water Local Service Area or the Fernwood Water Local Service Area; and
 - (ii) One member shall be a resident elector of the Salt Spring Island Electoral Area.
- (d) In Schedule "B", section 1, Description of Services, replacing section 1(d) with the following:
 - 1(d) The Fernwood and Highland Water Service Commission operates services for the supply, conveyance, treatment, storage and distribution of water within the Fernwood Water Local Service Area, more particularly described in Bylaw No. 1772, "Fernwood Water Supply Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1, 1989" and any amendments thereto, and in the Highland Water Local Service Area, more particularly described in Bylaw No. 1937, "Highland Water System Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1, 1991" and any amendments thereto;
- (e) In Schedule "A", section 1, Membership, by replacing section 1(g) with the following:
 - 1(g) The Maliview Sewer Local Service Commission, administering the Maliview Sewer Local Service Area, shall consist of the Director plus (three) other persons appointed by resolution of the Regional Board as follows:
 - (i) Two (2) members shall be resident electors of the Maliview Sewer Local Service Area: and
 - (ii) One (1) member shall be a resident elector of the Slat Spring Island Electoral Area.
- (f) In Schedule "B", section 1, Description of Services, replacing section 1(g) with the following:
 - 1(g) The Maliview Sewer Local Service Commission operates a service for the collection, conveyance, treatment and disposal of sewage within the Maliview Sewer Local Service Area, as more particularly described in Bylaw No. 1938, "Maliview Estates Sewerage Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1, 1991".
- (g) By removing section 8(b)(i) in its entirety.
- 2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Salt Spring Island Water, Sewer and Liquid Waste Disposal Commissions Bylaw No. 1, 2010, Amendment No. 1, 2020".
