**A BYLAW TO AMEND THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE PENINSULA RECREATION COMMISSION  
(BYLAW NO. 2397)**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. Under Bylaw No. 2397, Peninsula Recreation Commission Bylaw No. 1, 1996, the Regional Board established a commission to administer the recreation facilities shared the Municipality of North Saanich, Central Saanich, and Sidney as applicable;
- B. The current structure does not allow for alternate directors to properly represent the member local governments in the administered services; and
- C. The Board of the Capital Regional District wishes to amend Bylaw No. 2397 to ensure fulsome representation from the member local governments;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board of the Capital Regional District in open meeting assembled hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw No. 2397, "Peninsula Recreation Commission Bylaw No. 1, 1996" is hereby amended as follows:
  - (a) By amending section 1 (a), (b) and (c) to state:
    - (a) The Mayor of North Saanich;
    - (b) The Mayor of Sidney;
    - (c) The Mayor of Central Saanich;
  - (b) By amending section 1 (h) to state:
    - (h) In the absence of a Mayor from a participating municipality, an alternate member from the Council of a participating municipality may be nominated by that Council and appointed by the Regional Board to attend the commission in the Mayor's absence.
  - (c) By inserting the following as section 1 (j):
    - (j) An alternate under sections 1(h) and 1(i) may take the place of, vote and generally act in all matters for the applicable absent Mayor or council member. An alternate holds office until another council member is appointed as a replacement, or the alternate resigns, and the regional district corporate officer is notified in writing. If the seat of a Mayor or council member becomes vacant through resignation, disqualification or death, the alternate may continue in place of the mayor or council member whose seat became vacant until a new mayor or council member is appointed.

2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Peninsula Recreation Commission Bylaw No. 1, 1996, Amendment Bylaw No. 5, 2019".
