BYLAW NO. 4758

A BYLAW TO AMEND FIRE REGULATION BYLAW NO. 2, 2022 (BYLAW NO. 4489)

WHEREAS:

- A. Under Bylaw No. 4489, "Fire Regulation Bylaw No. 2, 2022", the Regional Board enacted a revised bylaw to regulate fire prevention and forest protection in the Juan de Fuca and Southern Gulf Islands Electoral Areas where local fire services are operated;
- B. The Board wishes to amend Bylaw No. 4489 to remove a section now covered in another bylaw, and to add the term 'Property Line' when prescribing setback distances from an open fire;

NOW THEREFORE, the Capital Regional District Board in open meeting assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 4489, "Fire Regulation Bylaw No. 2, 2022", is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) By deleting sections 4.1, 4.2, and 4.3 in their entirety, and renumbering the remaining sections.
 - (b) In section 5.2.2(a), 'Category 2 Open Fires', by inserting the words "property line" preceding the word "building".
 - (c) In section 5.2.4(a), 'Category 3 Open Fires – Exemption from the Open Burning Smoke Control Regulation', by inserting the words "property line" preceding the word "building".
2. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Fire Regulation Bylaw No. 2, 2022, Amendment Bylaw No. 1, 2026".
