**A BYLAW TO AMEND THE PARTICIPANTS UNDER “EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION  
DISPATCH SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2012” (BYLAW NO. 3854)**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. The Capital Regional District operates an emergency communication dispatch service for the areas of the City of Langford, the District of Highlands, the District of Metchosin, the District of Sooke, and the Salt Spring Island, Southern Gulf Islands, and the Juan de Fuca Electoral Areas;
- B. The City of Langford no longer desires to be part of the service, with its last full day being December 31, 2021, and the participants may amend the service by two-thirds consent of the participants and approval of the Inspector of Municipalities;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Capital Regional District Board in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw No. 3854 “Emergency Communication Dispatch Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1, 2012,” is amended as follows, effective January 1, 2022:
  - (a) In Section 2, Boundaries, by removing the “City of Langford”;
  - (b) In Section 3, Participating Area, by removing the “City of Langford”;
- 2. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “Emergency Communication Dispatch Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1, 2012, Amendment Bylaw No. 1, 2021”.
