BYLAW NO. 4756

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NOTICE ENFORCEMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2025
(BYLAW NO. 4683)

WHEREAS:

- A. Under Bylaw No. 4677, "Capital Regional District Fire Services Operational, Fire Prevention and Administrative Bylaw No. 1, 2026", the Regional Board designated and set out the process for designation of Fire Inspectors and Fire Investigators, and established and imposed charges payable in respect of Fire Inspection and Fire Investigation services;
- B. The Board wishes to amend Bylaw No. 4683, "Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw No. 1, 2025", to permit enforcement of certain contraventions of Bylaw No. 4677 by means of a bylaw notice in accordance with the *Local Government Bylaw Notice Enforcement Act* (Sections 4 and 6), and to establish penalty amounts in respect of such contraventions;

NOW THEREFORE, the Capital Regional District Board in open meeting assembled hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw No. 4683, "Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw No. 1, 2025" is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) In Appendix 1, by adding item 41 as follows:

"41. Capital Regional District Fire Services Operational, Fire Prevention and Administrative Bylaw No. 1, 2026	Bylaw Enforcement Officer Fire Chief Fire Inspector Peace Officer RCMP Officer
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 - (b) By adding Appendix 41 to Schedule A, attached as Appendix "1" to this Bylaw.
- 2. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw No. 1, 2025, Amendment Bylaw No. 2, 2026".
