

GACS is seeking capital funds to build a public playground for children aged 2-6 years on the Community School grounds, a community hub that includes the Activity Centre, the new Galiano Daycare, the Library, and the Community Greenhouse. This site does not currently have a play structure for preschool-aged children. The proposed public playground will be open to community members and visitors, and will also be used by the new Daycare program and by the school's StrongStart program.

GACS oversees and facilitates a wide diversity of community sports programs, classes, children's camps, workshops and events, including Galiano's first licensed, subsidized daycare, opening this fall. The addition of this playground will allow us to improve and increase the recreational opportunities available to our youngest community members.			
DESCRIBE HOW THE PROJECT RELATES TO THE GAS TAX FUNDING OBJECTIVES OF SUPPORTING PRODUCTIVITY AND ECONOMIC GROWTH, A CLEAN ENVIRONMENT, AND STRONG CITIES AND COMMUNITIES. (MAX. 800 CHARACTERS) According to the SGI Economic Development Commission, Galiano Island is disproportionately made up of seniors, and that poses challenges across multiple sectors. Attracting new young families to Galiano is essential to ensuring the future of this island community through their participation in the island economy and their involvement in providing the island's many volunteer-based community services, but it depends on providing the services they need, including facilities for young children. Outdoor playspaces are developmentally important for young children. According to UBC's CHILD Consortium, part of the Human Early Learning Partnership, "Outdoor play spaces...can enhance physical and cognitive development, encourage imaginative play, and stimulate empathy...[and] may also provide a restorative environment for children."
