# **SUBJECT** Community Works Fund Applications

## ISSUE

To approve the attached Community Works Fund (CWF) grant application.

### BACKGROUND

The Community Works Fund (CWF) is delivered to all local governments in British Columbia through a direct annual allocation to support local priorities.

The 2014-2024 Community Works Fund Agreement between the CRD and the Union of BC Municipalities (CWF Agreement) specifies the CRD's roles and responsibilities with regard to the expenditure and reporting of CWF.

CWF grant proposals are subject to Electoral Area Director approval prior to being submitted for Capital Regional District Board approval.

An initial application of \$20,100 for the Thieves Bay Park Lawn Enhancement project was approved at the August 2, 2017, CRD Board meeting. The same project is requesting an additional \$26,000, for a total CWF funding contribution of \$46,100.

### **IMPLICATIONS**

The proposed project meet the terms and conditions as outlined in the 2014-2024 Community Works Fund Agreement between the CRD and the Union of British Columbia Municipalities (UBCM). Additionally, CRD administrative and operational implications have been taken into consideration.
