## CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT WORK PLAN FOR REMOVAL OF ABANDONED AND DERELICT VESSELS October 2017

Based on the clarification from Transport Canada, it was determined that a multi-phased approach would be required to deal with the abandoned and derelict vessels in the Capital Region.

Schedule	Tasks
Aug/September 2017	Work with municipal partners to conduct an immediate inventory of known abandoned, wrecked and partially sunken vessels in as many areas as possible and submit documentation to Transport Canada to begin the process
September 2017	Submit an application for Abandoned Boats Program Education & Awareness funding to create and distribute outreach materials guiding boat owners about proper end-of-life options for boat disposal
October 2017	Submit an application for Assessment funding for all approved vessels for the October 30 funding intake (estimate 20 vessels will be included)
November/Dec 2017	Continue to inventory and serve notice on remaining areas with a focus on boats at anchor that appear to be abandoned or derelict. Apply for Assessment funding in batches.
Nov 2017 – Jan 2018	Once funding is approved, engage a consultant to complete Assessments for all approved vessels
February 2018	Apply for Removal and Disposal funding for all abandoned vessels that have been assessed
Spring/Summer 2018	Tender contract for removal and disposal of approved abandoned vessels

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
