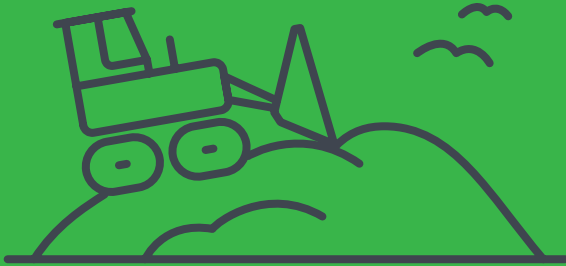

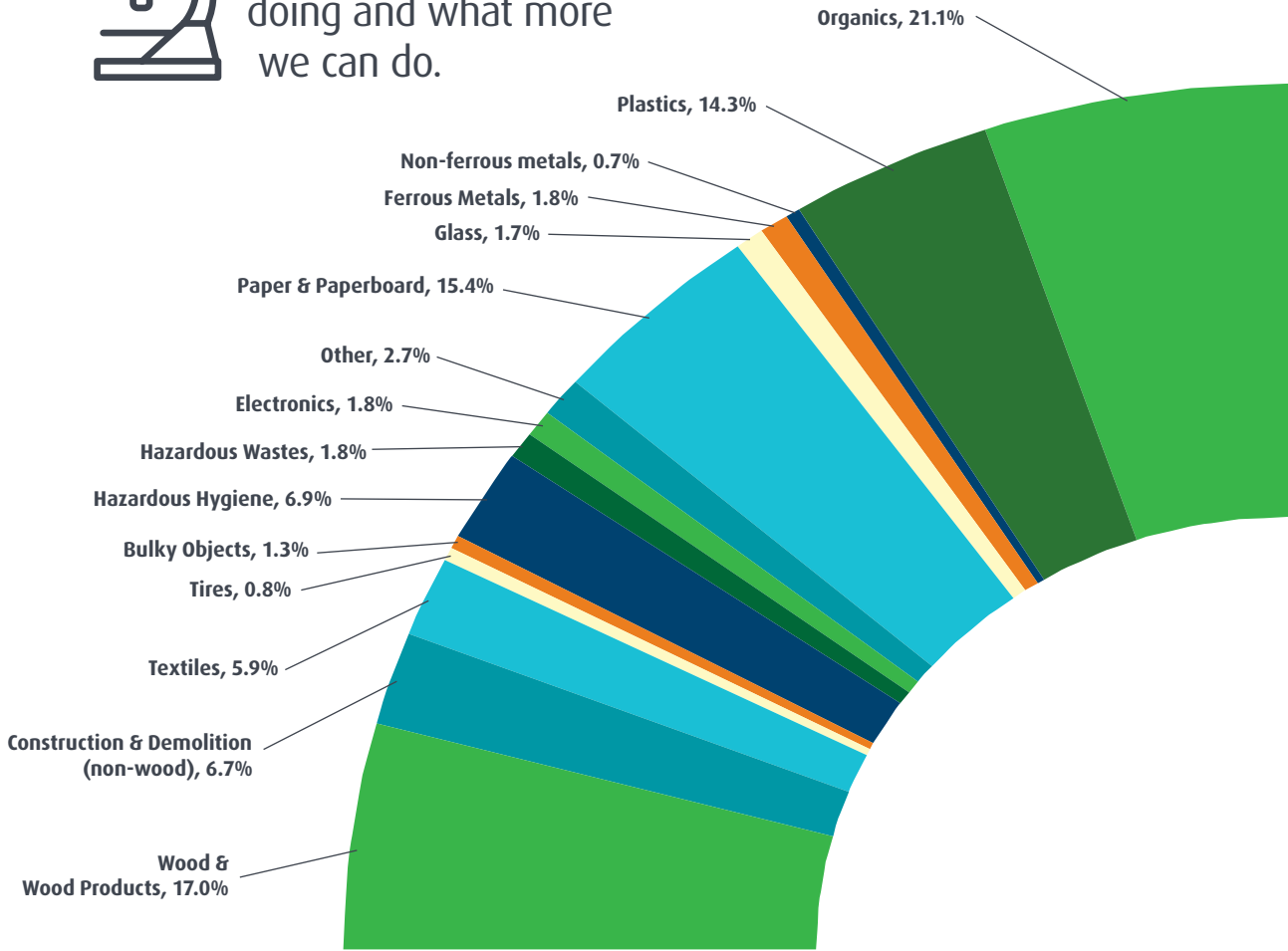

How Can We Reduce Waste?



Reduce

Reduce the amount or the toxicity of material that enters the solid waste stream and also the impact on the environment of producing it in the first place.



Reuse

Ensure that materials or products are reused as many times as possible before entering the solid waste stream.



Recycle

Recycle as much material as possible.



Recover

Recover as much material and/or energy from the solid waste stream as possible through the application of technology.
