**Question**

- If not at Hartland, who would be responsible for siting process?

**Question**

- What material streams will the CRD guarantee?

- CRD controlled feedstock (Biosolids)



- Local government controlled feedstock (30% of Kitchen Scraps, Leaf and Yard, 15% of Garbage)

**Question**

- Would the CRD be willing to solicit other feedstock?

**Question**

- Would the CRD want the IRM respondents to solicit other feedstock?

**Question**

- Who will be responsible for marketing recovered materials and risk?

**Question**

- Who will be responsible for energy offtake agreements and risk?

**Question**

- Should the CRD ban on land application of Biosolids apply to any beneficial use product from IRM using biosolids feedstock, this is used in some form on 'land' (i.e. biochar, aggregate)
