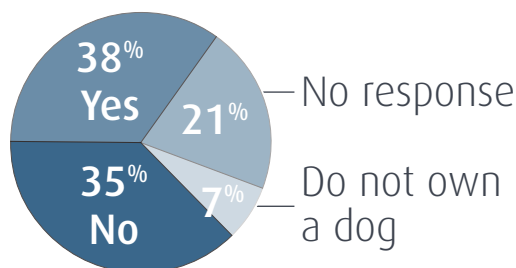
Why do you visit?

Do you visit with a dog?

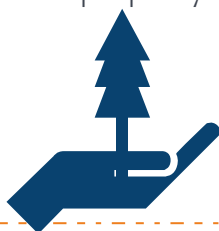


55% of participants supported the increase in funding to operate regional parks and trails
