


CRD Regional Parks Resident Survey 2017

Resident survey in 2017 to collect public opinions about the regional park and trail system




5000 Households 1245 Participants 27% Response



Data statistically valid and representative of CRD (95% confidence level)

21% Dogs off leash


14[%] Too far

Results



55% of participants supported the increase in funding to operate regional parks and trails

Priorities for the next 5 years

- 1. Repair and maintain facilities
- 2. Environmental restoration projects
 - 3. Acquire more parkland
