6.3. 19-662 Process and Steps to Create a Unified Fire Dispatch in the New South Island 911/Police Dispatch Centre

K. Lorette provided an overview of the report.

Discussion ensued on the following:

- the range of support from the region's Fire Chiefs
- the concerns with E-Comm performing the study
- the cost advantages and disadvantages
- providing clarity on a unified system model

MOVED by Director Hicks, SECONDED by Director Ranns, That the Planning and Protective Services Committee reject the staff recommendation.

MOVED by Director Desjardins, SECONDED by Director Young, That the motion be amended to refer the discussion on how we build a unified system regarding a way forward, to a working group of Fire Chiefs and CRD staff.

The Chair ruled the amendment out of order.

The chair was challenged and the question was called if the Chair shall be sustained.

The chair was sustained with Directors Ranns, Desjardins and Young opposed.

The question was called on the original motion.

MOVED by Director Hicks, SECONDED by Director Ranns,

That the Planning and Protective Services Committee reject the staff recommendation.

OPPOSED: Directors Orr, Mersereau, Windsor, Young, and Board Chair Plant

MOVED by Director Orr, SECONDED by Board Chair Plant,

That the Planning and Protective Services Committee recommend to the Capital Regional District Board:

- 1. That staff be directed to bring forward a budget proposal of \$50,000 within the 2020 Legislative and General Service's budget to complete a feasibility process to look at a unified fire dispatch model for the region that may include the Saanich facility, the E-Comm facility, the CRD Langford facility and the Surrey dispatch facility; and
- 2. Ensure that the feasibility report includes a complete and comprehensive response from all the region's fire chiefs.

MOVED by Director Young, SECONDED by Board Chair Plant, That the motion be amended to add "3. That the study also include the examination of incorporation of dispatch of other services in relation with CREST, impact of new technology, availability of revenue, and means of addressing union issues."

That the motion be amended in number 2 to add the words "direct involvement and" after the words "ensure the feasibility report includes" and before the words "a complete and comprehensive response...".

MOVED by Board Chair Plant, SECONDED by Director Hicks, That the amendment to the motion be amended in number 2 to replace the additional words of "direct involvement and" with the words "includes the participation of the fire chiefs prior to and after the report is written".

MOVED by Director Ranns, SECONDED by Director Williams, That the motions be tabled.

MOVED by Director Orr, SECONDED by Director Haynes, That the amended motion be amended to replace the word "unified" with "optimal".

The amendment was ruled out of order.

The chair was sustained with Directors Haynes, Mersereau, Orr, McNeil-Smith, and Brice opposed.

MOVED by Director Desjardins, SECONDED by Director Ranns, That the motion, as amended, be postponed until after discussions with CRD staff and a discussion with Regional Fire Chiefs on the merits of going forward.

MOVED by Board Chair Plant, SECONDED by Director Haynes,
That the motion be amended to add the words "prior to the provisional budget
process" after the words "...going forward".
CARRIED

MOVED by Director Desjardins, SECONDED by Director Ranns, That the motion, as amended, be postponed until after discussions with CRD staff and a discussion with Regional Fire Chiefs on the merits of going forward, prior to the provisional budget process. CARRIED
