

**CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT
BYLAW NO. 4429**

**A BYLAW TO AMEND THE CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT DELEGATION BYLAW NO. 1, 2017
(BYLAW NO. 4186)**

WHEREAS:

- A. Under Bylaw No. 4186, "Capital Regional District Delegation Bylaw No. 1, 2017", the Regional Board delegates authority to commissions, staff, and volunteers for established authority levels;
- B. Under Bylaw No. 3343, "Officers', General Managers' and Management Staff's Bylaw No. 1, 2006", and in prior bylaws, the Board delegated to its Chief Administrative Officer the role of retaining legal counsel to advise on and defend the CRD in any legal proceeding.
- C. The Board desires to ensure its current process and policy for retention of legal counsel and defence to legal claim is maintained in bylaw; and to ensure legal action may be commenced in a timely fashion in civil and administrative actions where the regional district is a wronged party, pursuant to section 229(1) of the *Local Government Act* and current practice; and
- D. The Board wishes to amend Bylaw No. 4186 to document the current practice;

NOW THEREFORE, the Capital Regional District Board in open meeting assembled hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw No. 4186, "Capital Regional District Delegation Bylaw No. 1, 2017" is hereby amended by inserting as section 7.2:

Delegation of legal settlement authority

7.2 The Board delegates to the Chief Administrative Officer the ability to settle any action, claim, or demand up to a maximum value of \$2-million per claim.

- 2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Capital Regional District Delegation Bylaw No. 1, 2017, Amendment Bylaw No. 4, 2021".
