Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program

That the Capital Regional District submit grant applications for four proposals, as endorsed in the following resolutions:

1) That the Capital Regional District Board (the Board) authorize staff to submit an application for grant funding for *Fernwood Elementary School Athletic Field Upgrade* through the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program - Community, Culture and Recreation Program; and that the Board supports the project and commits to its share (\$250,650) of the project.

AND

2) That the Capital Regional District Board (the Board) authorize staff to submit an application for grant funding for the Mayne Island Regional Trail - Phase 1 Development to the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program - Community, Culture and Recreation Program; and that the Board supports the project and commits to its share (\$1,023,000) of the project.

AND

3) That the Capital Regional District Board (the Board) authorize staff to submit an application for grant funding for *Miners Bay Dock Improvements* through the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program - Rural and Northern Communities Program; and that the Board supports the project and commits to its share (\$30,000) of the project.

AND

4) That the Capital Regional District Board (the Board) authorize staff to submit an application for grant funding for *Wilderness Mountain Supply Improvements* through the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program - Rural and Northern Communities Program; and that the Board supports the project and commits to its share (\$345,000) of the project.
