### Curbside Blue Box Recycling - 2024 and Beyond

[At the May 18, 2022 Environmental Services Committee meeting, part 1 of the recommendation was amended to add collection vehicle emissions to the RFP process.]

The Environmental Services Committee recommends to the Capital Regional District Board:

1. That staff be directed to issue a Request for Proposals for a six-year contract for Board approval to provide residential curbside blue box collection, from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2029, and include in the Request for Proposals incentives or a scoring system to increase the likelihood of the provision of low or zero emission collection vehicles;

2. That staff be directed to return to the Environmental Services Committee and the Capital Regional District Board for direction prior to awarding the Request for Proposals; and

That staff accept the Recycle BC one-year extension to their current agreement with the CRD to provide service to the end of 2024, and then enter into a new five-year agreement with Recycle BC to provide residential curbside recycling services for the capital region on its behalf for January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2029.
